



Adult Priority of Service Policy

Approved: June 14, 2019

Purpose: To provide Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) requirements for Priority of Service for the Adult (AD) funding stream.

Policy: Statutory priority for the provision of Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) career and training services will be given to those Adult participants who are veterans and their eligible spouses, and/or are low-income, and/or are recipients of public assistance, and/or are basic skills deficient.

Priority of career and training services must be provided in the following order:

1. Veterans and their eligible spouses who are low-income, and/or are recipients of public assistance, and/or are basic skills deficient.
2. Individuals who are not veterans or their eligible spouses but are low-income, and/or are recipients of public assistance, and/or are basic skills deficient.
3. Veterans and their eligible spouses who are not low-income, and/or are not recipients of public assistance, and/or are not basic skills deficient.
4. Individuals who are not veterans or their eligible spouses and are not low-income, and/or are not recipients of public assistance, and/or are not basic skills deficient.
