

## Self-sufficiency Definition

**Board Approved:** June 14, 2019

**Definition:** Self-sufficiency, for the purposes of establishing eligibility for receipt of WIOA training services, shall mean:

- For Adults:
  - Full-time or part-time employment that pays at least 300% of the Lower Living Standard Income Level, (LLSIL), according to the most recent definition published by the Department of Labor for a family of one, along with medical coverage for the participant; or
  - Full-time or part-time employment that pays at least 400% of the LLSIL, without medical benefits.
  
- For Dislocated Workers:
  - Full-time employment at a wage rate at least 80% of the layoff wage, with medical coverage for the participant.
