

Eligible Training Provider List (ETPL) Process Administration Policy

Approved: June 14, 2019

Purpose: To provide guidance for training organizations wishing to provide training services under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA).

Policy: Nevadaworks is committed to providing quality programs for WIOA participants to ensure their success in the workforce. Only providers that the State determines to be eligible, as required in WIOA Sec. 122, may receive training funds under WIOA to provide training for participants who enroll in a WIOA funded program of training services.

Only those ETPL applications that Nevadaworks has reviewed and found to be accurate and within the purview of in-demand occupations of their local area shall be forwarded, in a timely manner, to the State for consideration and approval.
